1) Review of Bond Market Developments and 2023 Outlook

Nathalie Fillet (BNP) will provide a review of bond market development since the last meeting on 13 September 2022 and give an outlook for the developments of euro area bond markets in 2023, with a focus on primary market activity.

2) Market functioning and the monetary policy normalisation of central banks

Julian Baker (JP Morgan) will touch upon the question whether heightened volatility in bond markets, can pose risks to market functioning. He will highlight the lessons from the turmoil in the UK bond market and provide an update on dealer's capacity to intermediate.

3) Latest developments in the ESG market

Bryan Pascoe (ICMA) will discuss the role of bond markets to finance energy transition and innovation and provide an update on the EU taxonomy.

4) Update on MiFIR regulation

Victoria Webster (AFME) will present an update on the MiFIR regulation with a focus on post-trade transparency requirements.
