

SSP V13 Qualified Configurations for Credit institutions and Ancillary systems

August 2019





In the tables below you can find two columns where system components qualified by the 3CB and valid for SSP release V13 are mentioned. Each column has to be read as a configuration set, i.e. no cross columns combinations are supported.

Customers using totally or partially different system components or versions than the ones mentioned here are responsible to verify the compatibility between their components and the ones listed in the table below in the test environment. In such case the 3CB can provide no technical support in case of problems.

These lists will be updated at every TARGET2 release.^a

Important news in this version of the qualified configurations is the completion of the migration from java applets to java plugin-free technology for Internet Access. From this version it will not be required anymore to have a Java Runtime Environment installed: Internet Explorer users will rely on the same configuration (based on the local installation of the Go>Sign Desktop Client) that has proved to be stable over the previous releases for Firefox users.

Approaching Windows 7 end of support, Windows 10 has been added in the supported Operating Systems list. Windows 7 will remain supported till 14 January 2020, Microsoft official end of life of this OS.

1.2. SWIFT Access
